Ministry of Finance approves regulations for launching "single window"

According to the Governmental Resolution No. 364 of 25 May 2016 various state controls over imported and exported goods would be performed under the "single window" principle. This would include a one-off submission of electronic copies of the permissive documents by importer to the customs office and subsequent exchange of information among controlling authorities.

To ensure launch of the "single window" system Ukraine's Ministry of Finance adopted the Order that defined documents required for completion of various state controls and approved lists of 192 customs clearance locations allowing "single window" and 47 border crossing points where automated radiation control is available.

The "single window" will start working from 1 August 2016.

The Order of the Ministry of Finance of Ukraine No. 657 "On Approval of the Lists of Data Required for Functioning of the Information-Telecommunication System of the Revenue Authorities" dated 25 July 2016.

We will continue to monitor amendments and inform you of developments in indirect tax legislation.
